Injured at the age of 6, Michael endured decades of medical indifference and emotional abuse. But his pursuit of joy and

balance has paid off. At 47, he has found a community of friends, a rare sense of purpose and the healing company of happy dogs.

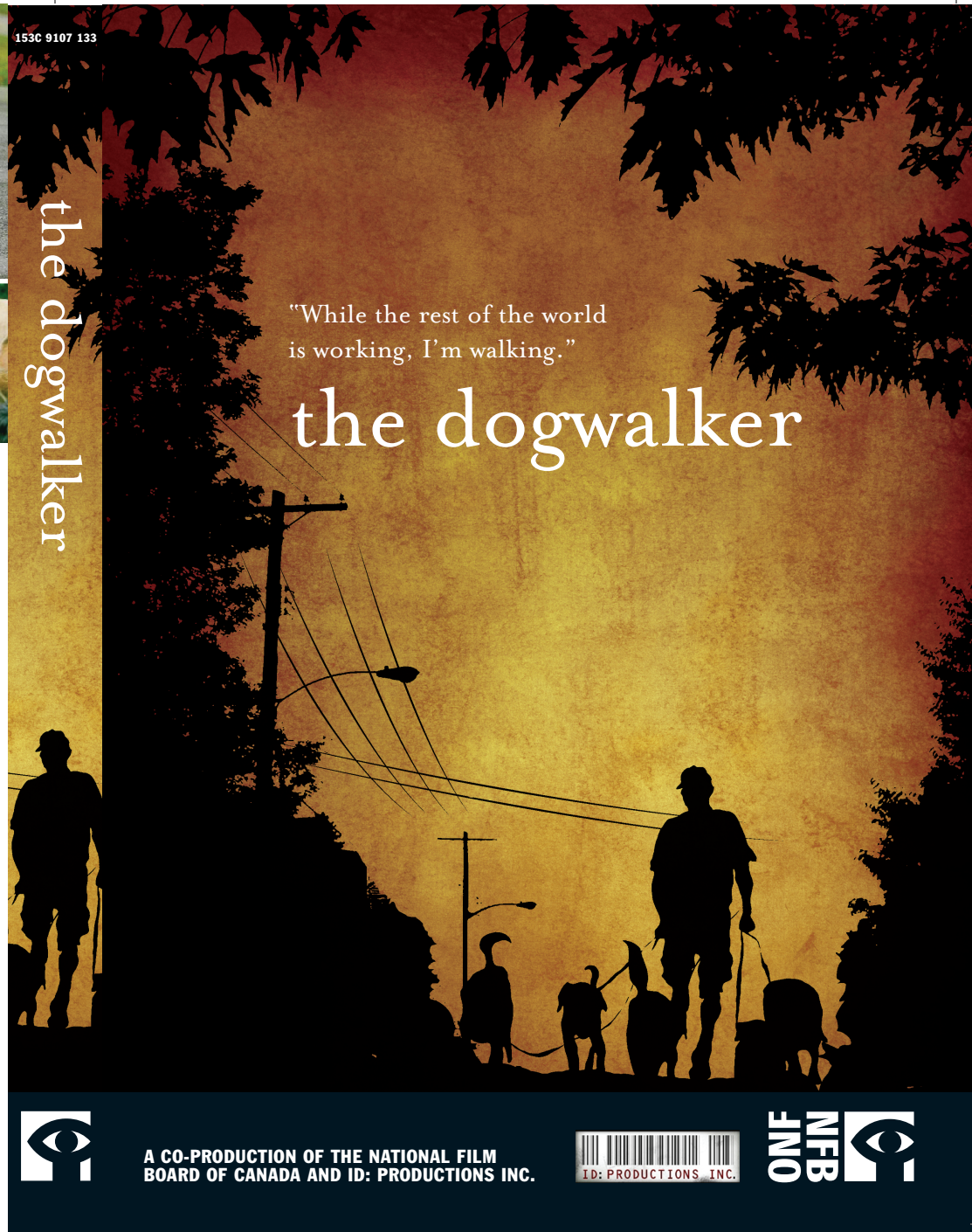
